

Facts about the world's largest ski flying hill

- World Record of 251.5 m
- K point: 200 meters
- Hill Size: 225 meters
- Length from top of the hill to end of the outrun: 570 meters
- Length of the inrun: 134 meters
- Angle of inrun: 36 degrees
- Distance between take off area to fall limit: 272 meters
- Angle of landing area (the steepest part): 38 degrees
- Angle K Point: 35 degrees
- Angle HS 225: 32 degrees
- Angle take off area: 10,8 degrees
- Height difference from the take off area to the K-point: 100.68 m
- Height difference from the take off area to fall limit: 135 meters
- Total height difference between top starting point and fall limit: 200.27 meters
- Width outrun by HS 225: 41 meters
- Velocity at take off: approx. 102 km / h.
- Velocity at landing: approx. 110-115 km / h.

The accommodation for teams will be in a hotel approximately 40 minutes by bus from the venue in Vikersund. The LOC has a good cooperation with the hotels and can promise you an adequate accommodation especially adjusted to the needs of the athletes and teams.

There will be an information desk at the hotel, attended by qualified and service minded staff skilled in languages.

Rooms for physical therapist, team meetings etc. can be booked directly from the reception and should be paid directly to the hotel together with other extras, such as parking, extra drinks etc.

Transportation

Transportation to and from the airport will be provided for free, however we need to be informed about your flight number in order to arrange swift transportation.

When you arrive Oslo Airport Gardermoen please look for the info point (SFWC 2015 Vikersund Info Desk Thursday) and you will be picked up and transported to your hotel.

Equipment transportation

In cooperation with the OC in Oslo and Trondheim, we will organize a truck to transport skis and equipment from Oslo to Trondheim and from Trondheim to Vikersund. Shuttle Service - Hotel - Venue

The nominating National Ski Associations are responsible for insuring their own athletes. All competitors must sign the "Athletes' Declaration". The event organizer is not liable for any injuries, or for any accidents involving a third party.

Reimbursement

The organizer will reimburse the athletes and their leaders/trainers for accommodation expenses according to the FIS rules. Athletes and leaders beyond the quota must pay directly to the hotel..
