

ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping World Cup Zakopane 2021 Organizing Committee takes care of full board accommodation for athletes and officials. The bookings for national teams are organized by the LOC according to team quotas and sent entries.

2 single rooms per team are guaranteed according to FIS rules. Further requests are subject to availability.

The official World Cup hotel for teams is COS Sports Hotel in Br. Czecha 1, 34-500 Zakopane. The price for daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is 65 Euro per person FB. Cash and credit cards are accepted.

If there are any NSF who had made their own accommodation arrangements they are obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than 1st January 2021.

The LOC does not guarantee availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than 1st January 2021. If available, only alternative accommodation shall be provided. Deadline for free of charge cancellation of rooms is 2 weeks prior to planned arrival. For rooms booked and not used full price for the whole duration will be charged.

COVID-19

Competitions shall be carried out in accordance with recommendations from Polish health authorities (National Institute of Hygiene and Sanitary, Epidemiological Station), World Health Organisation and International Ski Federation.

As of 15th November 2020 there are no restrictions for teams and officials travelling into Poland for international sport events (no PCR, no quarantine required) provided that entering individuals are able to prove the fact of the event being held and that they are officially entered as participating athletes/team officials, judges, accredited journalists.

After name entries are submitted by given deadlines, LOC will provide each team/official with written confirmation that might be required on entering Poland.

Shall there be any updates, we will inform everybody concerned accordingly.

All entered event participants being holders of FIS passport shall regularly follow general FIS Passport regulations, i.e. provide/fill in as required pre-entry health questionnaire, daily questionnaire, whereabouts for last 14 days prior to event.

PREVENTION AND MITIGATION PLAN

Detailed prevention and mitigation plan will be sent out to participating teams closer to competition dates.

PCR TEST ON DEPARTURE
