

ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping World Cup Zakopane 2022 Organizing Committee takes care of full board accommodation for athletes and officials. Bookings for national teams are organized by the LOC according to team quotas and sent entries.

The official World Cup hotel for teams is COS Sports Hotel in Br. Czecha 1, 34-500 Zakopane. According to World Cup Rules (Men) 2021/2022 point. 6.2.1 "for nations with starting quota 4 or more two single rooms have to be provided."

Additional single rooms are subject to availability. They will not be available until confirmed by the LOC.

The price for daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is 80 Euro per person FB.

Single supplement for additional and in-quota single rooms 30 Euro pp.

Cash and credit cards are accepted.

If there are any NSF who had made their own accommodation arrangements they are obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than 1st January 2021.

The LOC does not guarantee availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than 10th December 2021.

If available, alternative accommodation shall be provided.

Deadline for free of charge cancellation of rooms is 14 days prior to planned arrival.

COVID-19

Competitions shall be carried out in accordance with recommendations from Polish health authorities (National Institute of Hygiene and Sanitary, Epidemiological Station), World Health Organisation and International Ski Federation.

As of 20th October 2021 there are no restrictions for teams and officials travelling into Poland for international sport events (no PCR, no quarantine required) provided that entering individuals are able to prove the fact of the event being held and that they are officially entered as participating athletes/team officials, judges, accredited journalists. There are also no restrictions travelling into Poland for fully vaccinated against Covid-

19 and officially recovered from Covid-19 (Covid passport required).

After name entries are submitted by given deadlines, LOC will provide each team/official with written confirmation that might be required on entering Poland.

Shall there be any updates, we will inform everybody concerned accordingly.

All accredited FIS passport holders are required to regularly follow general FIS Passport regulations, including

- filling in pre-entry health questionnaire and daily questionnaire, as required
- providing negative RT_PCR result not older than 72 hours on arrival, the result shall be entered into the FIS passport application not later than 12 hours before arrival day.

Deadline for FIS passport application for the event – 11th January 2022.

PREVENTION AND MITIGATION PLAN

Detailed prevention and mitigation plan will be sent out to participating teams closer to competition dates.

PCR TEST ON DEPARTURE

Shall there be any teams who require PCR test on departure from Poland, please inform LOC as soon as possible (@ <u>a.baczkowska@tzn.pl</u>) so these can be arranged in time.
